


Through these activities, students develop leadership skills, learn teamwork, and explore their interests outside of the classroom.

DTES also hosts special events throughout the year, such as the annual Fall Festival and the Winter Wonderland Carnival.



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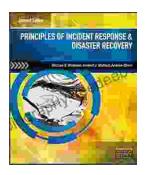
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
